At Inn on Prince Hotel & Conference Centre Truro it is our pleasure to welcome your four-legged family members. We have designated select rooms in the hotel as pet or service animal friendly so please be sure to inform the hotel that you are bringing your pet when making your reservation.

To ensure a comfortable stay for yourself and your fellow guests, we would appreciate it if you would please observe the following guidelines:

- A maximum of two (2) domesticated animals allowed per room with a combined weight of not more than 100lbs. Pets of a 'heftier' variety must be approved by the General Manager.
- A pet fee of \$25/per pet will be applied to your account once per stay, additional fees may be incurred should there be significant additional cleaning required.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times in public areas and (with the exception of service animals) are not allowed in our restaurant, lounge, pool area, fitness centre or any other common area.
- Housekeeping services may only be provided while your pet is out of the room, please contact the front desk to make arrangements.
- Pets left unattended in your room must be in a pet crate or carrier, you must also leave a cell# for emergency contact with the front desk.
- Guests are responsible for cleaning up after your pet while on hotel property and in the neighbourhood.
- Please note that if a disturbance is caused by your pet/service animal that affects the comfort of other guests you may be expected to compensate the hotel for potential loss of revenue. If complaints are frequent, we may be obliged to ask you to leave.
