The Bay of Fundy's Minas Basin is home to the highest tides in the world! The incoming Fundy tides are so significant that twice a day they temporarily reverse the flow of several rivers that empty into the Bay. Talk to friendly staff at the visitor centre to get tidal bore and tide times along with information on area attractions. Stop for a picnic, washroom break, or stretch your legs by walking or cycling the nearby Cobequid Trail. Have fun with the kids on the natural playground or finish your day with a tranquil view and extraordinary sunset.
